Claude W. Bailey, Chairman, presiding, the following business was transacted:

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and un-animously carried, that the County Attorney be and is hereby directed to file suit against Public Dump Grounds, located one-half mile East of Yale on East 21st Street, and ratify the proceedings already taken in that respect.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and un-animously carried, that the County Attorney be and he is hereby directed to file suit against Public Dump Grounds located approximately one-fourth of a mile East of Yale and South of Fifteenth Street.
