Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, January 19th, 1942, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Ralsa F. Morley and Curtis Greer, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Gray who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Greer. The Chairman of the Board ordered the resolution read, to-wit:

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Highway Department is in need of an automobile and has found that Wyeth Luttrell has a 1934 White Truck, Motor Number 1244, Model 702, and that said White Truck can be purchased by the Highway Department from Wyeth Luttrell for a consideration of Three Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$325.00).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners be authorized to purchase said White Truck, and that the County Highway Department be authorized to draw a claim to Wyeth Luttrell in the sum of Three Hundred and Twenty-Five Dollars (\$325.00), payable from Account Number 8, designated as "Purchase of Tools, Trucks and Equipment" of the County Highway Department Account of the Cash Fund.
