## - R E S O L U T I O N -

At a regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, held on the 6th. day of February, 1922, the following resolution was introduced by Ira Short, member of the Board, who, after reading the same moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by F.M. Wooden, member of the Board and upon roll call was unanimously carried.

WHEREAS, the surveys, plans, specifications and estimated of the roads in Dawson Township, Tulsa County, authorized to be improved by the proceeds of a certain Bond Issue voted by the voters thereof, has, by the County Engineers Office been completed, and

WHEREAS, said Bonds have been by this Board sold under the terms of a certain agreement made for their purchase, and

WHEREAS, that said work may proceed as quickly as possible in order that idle labor may be given employment and that the said work may not unnecessarily be delayed,

BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board do approve the said plans, surveys and estimates, and the specifications governing the same, and that the County Clerk and the County Engineer be authorized to advertise in the name of this Board for the receiving of proposals for the improvement of said roads; such proposals if any be presented, to be opened and considered by this Board on the 20th. day of February, 1922, between the hours of two (2) and three (3) o'clock P.M. and such advertisement to Contractors to have embodied therein, the right to reject any or all bids for any reasons justifiable in the opinion of this Board.
