### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of February, 1928, the County of Tulsa acquired an easement and right of way to the hereinafter described property for road building and highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, a part of said tract is no longer essential for right of way purposes and has never been used as such, and it is the desire of the Board of County Commissioners to relinquish and release to the abutting property owner, to-wit, Louise M. Newton, that portion of said tract which has never been used and is not necessary for road building or right of way purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners direct and authorize J. W. Hardesty, Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to execute a quit claim deed to Louise M. Newton of the following described real estate, to-wit:

That tract of land that is bounded on the west by a line that lies 30' east of the center of Yale Ave., and is bounded on the South by a line that lies 40' north of the center of the 64' pavement on Admiral Place Blvd., and is bounded on the southwest by the northeasterly edge of the "cut-off" paving that lies on a curve running from Admiral Place Blvd to Yale Ave., and is bounded on the northeast by a curve that has radius of 166.2' and a length of 261.1', said curve being described in right-of-way deed from W. C. Charley to Tulsa County in Book 670, page 226 of the records on file in the office of Tulsa County Clerk, all of Section 3, Township 19N, Range 13E, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.




