

Motion by Commissioner Morley, seconded by Commissioner Sallee, that the report of Drainage Ditch Commissioner of Frye Drainage District No. 1, J. C. Walker, asking that a levy to raise \$1,000 be made on the property of the district having been received, due and proper notice of the hearing on said request having been given for this day and this hour and no person having appeared and protested to said assessment, that said report should be approved and said assessment made and the County Assessor of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, is ordered and directed to spread said assessment upon the tax rolls to be assessed against the property in the district in the same apportionment as the assessment for the original construction of the Drainage District. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Shepard, Aye; Morley, Aye; Sallee, Aye. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Sallee, seconded by Commissioner Morley, that the report filed by A. F. Ezzell, Livestock and Meat Inspector of Tulsa County, for the month of September, 1940, of two hogs and one beef slaughtered for human consumption at the Tulsa County Farm, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
