IN THE MATTER OF ERECTING AND MAINTAINING TELEPHONE :
LINES AND POLES THROUGH AND ACROSS CERTAIN HIGHWAYS : ORDER
IN THE VICINITY OF TURLEY, OKLAHOMA. :

NOW, on the 22nd. day of April, 1929, the matter of the petition of ELSIE BRITTON to construct and maintain telephone lines and poles and other facilities used in connection therewith through and across certain highways in said County of Tulsa, came up before the Board of County Commissioners for hearing; and,

It appearing to the Board that it was proper that said Elsie Britton be permitted to use as much of the highways as is proper and reasonable, all as shown on the plats and drawings attached to said petition, and according to the descriptions contained in said petition all of which is referred to in this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that said right and permission be granted, with the understanding that such telephone lines, poles and other facilities used in connection therewith will be so constructed and maintained that the same will not interfere with the proper use by the general public of said highways, and that the same will be constructed and maintained in accordance with the rules and regulations of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing the same.

It is further ordered that such right and permission be hereby granted to the said petitioner, Elsie Britton, her heirs and assigns, to use as much of said highways for the above indicated purposes, all in accordance with law in such cases made and provided.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to MRS I A SCHUMAN of a deed conveying to her for a consideration of One Hundred Fifty Four and 74/100 (\$154.74) the following described lots:
