

July 17, 1940

TUESDAY, JULY 17, 1945

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Claude W. Bailey, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

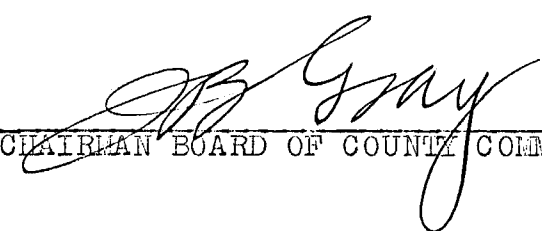
Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment filed and approved by Dan A. Rowe, County Assessor, in favor of J. H. Manley in the amount of \$1.18 covering Personal tax for the year 1944, be and the same is hereby approved and the County Clerk is hereby instructed to issue certificate of error covering same. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Cash Fund in the amount of \$6,824.67 be approved and the Chairman of the Board be authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Cash Fund Estimate of Needs and Request for Appropriation for the County Highway Restricted Cash Fund in the amount of \$3,754.14, be approved and the Chairman of the Board be authorized to sign same and submit it to the Excise Board for their consideration. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

C. T. Cagle, Superintendent of the Fair Grounds, deposited with the County Treasurer, \$50.00 covering rent from July 15th, to August 15th, 1945, of the N.Y.A. Barracks #3 to John Reid. Misc. No. 47973 - same was ordered filed.

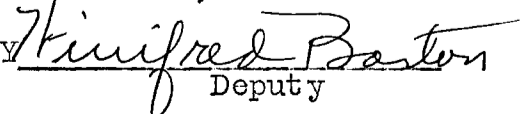
