J. D. Jones was on motion of Board appointed constable Tulsa Township.

The Bond of Geo W. Davis was approved as const of the County Court. The Bond of J. D. Jones as Constable was approved by the Board.

Professor Maxwell was appointed associated School Examiner in place of J. G. Moore moving from the county. In the matter of Road Petition of Ben Polson the same was granted and the following viewers H. H. Waller, J. W. Jones & Tom Blair were appointed together with the county Surveyor to meet on Sept 7 1910 and view and layout said road.

The report of the viewers for road at the east end of Jenkins Bridge was on for hearing Mr Elliott appearing for Rosella Gee the hearing was postponed until Aug. 9 1910.

Commissioners adjourned to meet Aug 9 1910 at 9 P.M.
