O R D E R

NOW, On this 15th. day of November, 1926, the matter of the petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for pwrmission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board, and each of the commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows:

Beginning at a point in the Northeast Corner of Section 1, Township 21 North, Range 13 East, and running thence East to a point near the Northwest corner of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 14 East, thereby crossing the North and South Secton lines between Section 1-21-13 and Section 6-21-14, between Sections 6 & 5, and 5 & 4, of Township 21 North, Range 14 East, together with any other public roads or highways that may be crossed by a pipe line laid in accordance with blue print of survey hereto attached and made apart of the Petition herein.

This line known as "Line J-2 Extension", an eight inch gas pipe line.

And, it further appearing from the petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as no to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED and ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
