Be It Remembered That, on the 6th day of September, 1910, The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, met in regular session with the following members present:

W.L. North, Chairman, C.L. Cleveland and Geo. McKeown, C. S. Rogers, County Clerk, acting as Clerk of the Board. The following, among other proceedings, were had:

C.L. Cleveland introduced a resolution ratifying and confirming the execution and issuance of Bridge Bonds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to the amount of \$75,000, which resolution is in words and figures as follows, to-wit:

"A resolution ratifying and confirming the execution and issuance of Bridge bonds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to the amount of \$75,000, and amending all resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict herewith.

Whereas, by resolutions heretofore passed, The Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, authorized and directed the execution and issuance of bridge bonds of said County to the amount of \$75,000, said bonds to be dated June 1, 1910, and maturing serially from 1921 to 1930 and bearing interest at the rate of 5% per annum and payable semi-annually, and whereas, said resolution authorized said bonds to be designated as "Bridge bonds of 1909," and
