

for permission to lay, maintain and operate a pipe line or lines for the transportation of water, gas and oil, along and across the Section lines and public highways of Tulsa County Oklahoma, described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 10 East thence South one and one-half miles along the Section line between Sections 6-19-10 and Section 1-19-9, and between Section 7-19-10 and Section 12-19-9 to the Southwest corner of the Northwest Quarter of Section 7-19-10, The Eastern oil Company making certain undertakings in connection therewith as in its said application more fully appears; and the said application having been discussed and considered and the Board being fully advised in the premises, and being of the opinion that the welfare of said Tulsa County would be promoted by fostering and encouraging industrial enterprises of this kind, to the end that the taxable values of said County will be increased and the business thereof stimulated;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is considered and ordered by the Board of County Commissioners that permission be and hereby is granted to said Eastern oil Company, its successors and assigns to lay, maintain and operate a pipe line or lines for the transportation of water, oil and Gas in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, along and across the said Section lines and public highways of said County; PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that said pipe line or lines shall be laid, maintained and operated as not to obstruct said section lines and public highways for the purpose of public travel, use and convenience, and PROVIDED, further, that the said Eastern Oil Company, shall, as in its said application, it has undertaken to do, hold said Tulsa County Harmless against any claims for damages for any matter or thing in connection with or growing out of the laying, operating and maintaining of said pipe line or lines.
