Parkinson, County Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and he is hereby authorized to invest \$30,000 of County Sinking Funds, excluding Homesteads, in United States Tax Notes, Series "C". Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of Jess Tabor be accepted as of September 10th, 1943, and that he be granted a leave of absence for a period of six (6) months. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of L. F. Barrett be accepted as of September 15th, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that a duplicate deed be issued to Wm. Diblick covering Lots 8 and 9, Block 33, Highland Park Addition to the City of Collinsville, for the reason that original deed was lost and was never recorded. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that a recess be taken until Tuesday, September 21st, 1943, at the hour of 2:00 O'Clock P.M. Motion carried.
