for the cost of an engineering investigation pertaining to Flood prevention and control along Bird Creek from the Osage Line to the Rogers County Line across Tulsa County.

A proposition has been submitted to us by competent engineers to make such a preliminary investigation as would be necessary to lead up to the formation of a proposed Improvement District. The estimated expense of which would be \$1,500.00 and we feel that since this proposed improvement district directly affects all of the Highways and Bridges within and adjacent with this proposed District and the further fact such improvement, if such can be carried out, is of vital interest to the people as a whole of Tulsa County and this Committee respectfully requests that you take such action as may be necessary to authorize the preliminary on the part of the County of the Cost of defraying such investigation.

Innthe matter of the application of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to use public highways forthe purpose of laying pipe lines, the following Order was made:

ORDER

NOW, On this the 29th. day of November, 1926, the matter of the petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said corporation, and according to said description, which is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the Northeast corner of Section 1,
Township 21 North, Range 13 East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma,
and running thence East to a point near the Northwest corner
of the NE<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 4, Twp 21 N., Rge. 14 E.,
thereby crossing the North and Scuth section lines between
Section 1-21-13 and Section 6-21-14, and between Sections
5 & 6, and 5 & 4 of Twp. 21 N., Rge. 14 E., and within and
paralleling the East and West Section line road 22 feet from
the center line thereof between Section 6-21-14 and Section
31-22-14; together with any other public roads or highways
that may be crossed by a pipe line laid in accordance with
blue print map of survey hereto attached, or attached to the
Petition herein, and made a part of the Petition. This line
known as "Line J-2 Extension", an eight inch (8") gas pipe line.

NOTE: This order supersedes and is to replace order made by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County Oklahoma in favor of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation, dated November 15th. 1926, covering this pipe line with slight change in location thereof.
