The following Petition was presented by Mr. R. C. Alder,:

The Board of County Commissioners is hereby petitioned to cancel tax sale and strike penalty on 1925 tax on E $\frac{1}{2}$  Lot 5, Crisbie Heights, South of Owen Addition, for reason that all of Lot 5 is owned by one and same party, namely, R C Alder and when paying his taxes he asked for the full amount of all taxes on Lot 5, and the taxes on only half or W $\frac{1}{2}$  of the Lot 5 was given him, he taking receipt with the understanding that all the tax on all of Lot 5 was included in payment.
