WHEREAS, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, by its Board of County Commissioners, desires to grant to the Missouri-Kansas-Texas Railroad Company, an easement for a right-of-way for the construction and maintenance of a spurtrack to the County Fair or Exposition Grounds in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, form of which easement is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part of this resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, that such easement for right-of-way be granted on behalf of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to said Railroad Company, in accordance with said form Exhibit "A" hereto, and that John H. Miller, as Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, and Andy Stokes, as County Clerk, be and they are hereby fully authorized, empowered and directed to execute the same on behalf of Tulsa County, and their action in so doing is hereby adopted, ratified and confirmed as the act of the Board of County Commissioners, and of Tulsa County, Oklahoma.
