MONDAY, April 16th, 1934.

The Board of County Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, April 16th, 1934, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and H. E. Bridges, Members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with, and there being no objections to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Chairman Miller presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the quarterly report of W. Watkins, Justice of the Peace of Jenks Township, Tulsa County, for the first quarter of the year of 1934, beginning on the first day of January and ending on the 31st day of March, 1934 be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

WHEREUPON, at the hour of 12:00 o'clock Noon, a recess is taken until 1:30 o'clock P.M.

AFTER RECESS 1:30 O'Clock P.M.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 1:30 o'clock P.M., with all members present and presiding as before.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the monthly report of the County Court be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the monthly report of E. A. Warterfield, Court Clerk, be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the monthly report of Frank Markham, Clerk Court of Common Pleas, be accepted and filed. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the Western Supply Company be granted permission to take up a 3-inch gas line that was originally constructed by the Continental Oil Company on West 33rd Avenue, from Edison Street to the M.K. & T. Ry Co's tracks, in Section 3, Township 19, Range 12 E. Upon roll call, all voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the Consolidated School District of Jenks, Oklahoma, be granted a permission to erect a high line along the east line of Section 9, Township 18, Range 13 E. This is an extension of the high line of approximately 3,250 feet along the east line of Section 9, Township 18, Range 13 E. Upon roll call, all voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Bridges, that the affidavit of erroneous assessment of Wiley and Elizabeth Hall covering personal property in the sum of \$12.58 be denied for the reason that the Board of County Commissioners have no jurisdiction over the matter. Upon roll call, all voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
