1985 Tulsa Area Vo-Tech meeting to discuss the concerns and also to draft legal questions on such an election for Board's submission to the District Attorney.

Moore also explained the Election Board has had several requests for countywide voter registration lists, as permitted under the new Oklahoma Open Records Act, becoming effective November, 1985. Chairman, Harris stated a special meeting on this subject would be needed since so many other County operations seem to be affected by the Act, especially data processing and schools.

County Personnel Director Terry Tallent appeared to explain, based upon correspondence between the District Attorney's office and the Wage and Hour Division of the U.S. Department of Labor, that Fair Labor Standards Act (FLSA) rulings on exempt/non-exempt status for group employee classifications would be extremely slow and that rulings on individual employees would be even slower. Chairman Harris requested the FLSA/county overtime policy subject be placed on the October 24, 1985 Management Conference agenda.

County Parks Director George Phillips appeared to request approval and execution of a User Agreement between the Board and Public Service Company which allows County, for primary term of five years, to use solely for recreational purposes approximately thirteen acres of land located near lllth Street and South Garnett Road. Motion by Rice, seconded by Harris, to approve Agreement and authorize chairman to execute same. Upon roll call, Selph, yes; Rice, yes; Harris, yes. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:55 a.m.
