In the matter of the hearing of protests on Assessments in proposed Water Improvement District No. 8 of Jno. B. Means, upon motion of W W Stuckey, which motion was duly seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, the objections were overruled. Upon roll call the following vote was cast: Stuckey, Yes. Hedgecock, Yes. North, No. Declared Carried.

Comes now Jno. B. Means and excepts and objects to the ruling of the County Commissioners upon the appraisal and assessment of the South Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 23, Twp. 19, Range 13 E., Tulsa County, Oklahoma, for the reason that the South Half ($S\frac{1}{2}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) and the South East Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter and the Southeast Quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of the the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) and the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northwest Quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of the Southwest Quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) is inaccessible to the proposed water lines of said District No. 8 as provided by Section 7092 Z21 relative to Water Improvement Districts.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, that M A Dixon be and he is hereby appointed Justice of the Peace within and for District No. 4, to serve in West Tulsa, Okla. Motion carried.

O R D E R.

WHEREAS, The Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to PREST O LITE COMPANY of a deed conveying to them for a consideration of Twelve and 40/100 (\$12.40) Dollars, the following described lots or tracts:

Tracts "F" and "G" McLane Addition to Tulsa.

AND, WHEREAS, the sale of said tracts by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1921, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax resale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treas. would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said tracts, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said tracts for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled and pursuant to the aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property by the County Treasurer to PREST O LITE COMPANY for a consideration of \$12.40, and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to them a deed conveying to them all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.
