The following Resolution was introduced by Commissioner Kinkaid, who moved its adoption; said motion being seconded by Commissioner Gray. Chairman ordered the Resolution read.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, on this 27th day of September, 1943, the County Commissioners in lawful session for the purpose of hearing any protests that might arise regarding the cleaning out the Frye Drainage Ditch in District No. 1, in County Commissioner's District No. 3, and

WHEREAS, there being no protests arising and there being seven (7) property owners affected by said ditch present to insist that due diligence be exercised in respect to cleaning out this ditch and that work commence at once, and

WHEREAS, it is recommended at this time that the County Clerk be directed to spread of record the assessment in the amount of \$4,000 upon the property affected by this Drainage ditch and present same to the County Assessor in order that it may be of record on or before October 1st, 1943, and thus being taxable in the year 1943.

The County Commissioners find that the sum of \$4,000 is reasonable in amount to be used for the repair and cleaning out of said ditch and that the necessity of repairing and cleaning out did not arise from the act or negligence of land owners or corporation in or through which drainage ditch runs or extends and that said \$4,000 should and is hereby divided pro rata according to the original assessments of benefits levied in this matter and the County Clerk shall place the same upon the tax books against the lands and crops, rents or profits therefrom, to be collected as taxes.
