J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the resignation of VERNON BLACKBURN, Truck Driver in the Highway Department, be and the same is hereby accepted as of October 1st, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of Philip Winsett, Truck Driver in the Highway Department, be and the same is hereby accepted as of October 1st, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that Philip Winsett be appointed Truck Driver in the Highway Department, District No. 3, as of October 1st, 1943, at the rate of \$150.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that H. E. Ward be appointed Head Mechanic in District No. 3, as of September 29th, 1943, at a salary of \$200.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the resignation of Geo. Clymer, Grader Operator, District No. 2, be and the same is hereby accepted as of October 1st, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that Lee Apple be appointed Caterpillar Driver or Patrol Operator as of September 27th, 1943, at a salary of \$160.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
