A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ira Short that the resolution approving and confirming the eport of the viewers in Park View Drainage District No.2, Tulsa County, Oklahoma: declaring the findings of the board relative to the notice of hearing, relating to exceptions to the construction of the proposed ditch in said district, making adjustments of said report, fixing the time and manner in which the work shall be done and the contract let, and declaring an emergency, be and the same is hereby approved. Motion carried by a unanimous vote.

A motion was made by Ira short and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the engineer in charge of the work in the Park View Drainage District No. 2, be authorized to advertise for bids for the construction of the said drainage project. Motion carried.

Pursuant to a petition filed by the Sand Springs Home, a corporation for the right and authority to construct a 20 inch metal pipe line across and through the Arkansas River XXXXXX for the purpose of transmitting and selling water to oil refineries, industries and manufacturing enterprises and to the inhabitants of Tulsa County, upon motion of Ira Short seconded by F. M. Wooden, the following order was made.
