furnish electricity, for heat, light and power to various inhabitants and municipalities within the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma; that said Sand Springs Home has entered into contracts to furnish various cities, towns and municipalities with electricity, and that in order to furnish said electricity to said towns, cities and municipalities and inhabitants thereof, it will be necessary to lay any maintain on, over and across the following public highways in said county, poles, wires and apparatus and other appliances as may be proper to transmit said electricity to said municipalities, to wit:

Along the public highway from Skiatook, Oklahoma to Avant, Oklahoma, beginning on the north line of the city limits of Skiatook, on the west side of road going north from the north city limits of the City of Skiatook through Section 23, township 22 north, range 12 east to the north line section 23, township 22 north, range 12 east, about 3000 feet, thence east on the south side of road between sections 23 and 14 township 22 North, Range 12 East, approximately 1300 feet, thence north on the east side of road between sections 13 and 14, township 22 north, range 12 east, approximately 5280 feet, thence north on the west side of road between sections 11 and 12, township 22, north, Range 12 east approximately 5280 feet, thence north on the west side of road between sections 1 and 12 township 22 north, range 12 east, approximately 5280 feet, thence west on the south side of road along the north line of section 22, township 22 north, Range 12 east, to and intersecting the west boundry of Cherokee Nation., approximately 2850 feet.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that the Sand Springs Home be and is hereby authorized to use the above described highways within said County for the purpose of constructing, laying and erecting the necessary poles, wires, apparatus and appliances and necessary appurtanences thereto for the purpose of transmitting and furnishing said electricity.

It is further ordered that the installation of said poles, wires, etc., shall be made under the direction of the County Engineer, and in such places and manner consistent with necessity to least interfere with other public uses of said highways, and said highways shall not be unnecessarily obstructed and shall within a reasonable time be placed as near as practicable in as good condition and repair as before such construction at the expenses of the said Sand Springs Home; that in the event the Board of County Commissioners decide at any time to widen the highways so used ^{by} said Sand Springs Home, that said Sand Springs Home will move its pole lines to conform to said highways at its own expense, and under the supervision of a County Engineer, and said Sand Springs Home will hold the County harmless from any liability arising from any negligence, act or omission.
