RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Tulsa County desires to open and construct a grade crossing on the section line road between sections 23 and 26, Township 19 North, Range 12 East, which will give access to territory surrounding Garden City in said county, and  
WHEREAS, a grade crossing at said point on the Midland Valley Railroad is required in order to accomplish said purpose, and  
WHEREAS, such questions properly come within the jurisdiction of the Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, for and on behalf of said Board sign and file with the Corporation Commission of the State of Oklahoma formal complaint asking that the Midland Valley Railroad Company be required to install a grade crossing over its tracks at the above described location.
