Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Greer, that the contract between the Tulsa County Welfare Department, B. E. McClendon, Director, and the War Food Administration for the storage and distribution of Federal Commodities as specified in contract be approved and that B. E. McClendon be designated as Commodity Distributor. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Gray, Aye; Greer, Aye; Kinkaid, No. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that an agreement be entered into with the Memorial Park for Tulsa County to pay to said Memorial Park the sum of \$12.50 for all County burials without exception, regardless of whether such burial was an infant, child or adult. Said price to become effective as of October 1st, 1943. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the bond filed by the Smith Brothers Abstract Company in the amount of \$5,000, and made by the National Surety Corporation, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the bond filed by the Guaranty Abstract Company in the amount of \$5,000 and made by the Fidelity and Deposit Company, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that a recess be taken until Monday, October 4th, 1943, at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A.M. Motion carried.
