That part of the West 50' of Lot 2, Block 4, Vern Subdivision No. 2, lying between the Arkansas River and a line described as follows: Beginning at a point on the West line of Lot 2, 259' South of the NW corner thereof; thence North 70°22' East a distance of 56.2' to the East line of the ~~East~~ said West 50' of said Lot 2, said line being 235.6' South of the North line of said Lot 2. AND WHEREAS, Tulsa County at this time is in need of said above described properties and due effort has been made to purchase the same.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Attorney of this County, in the name of the Board of County Commissioners and on behalf thereof, be and is hereby instructed to institute condemnation proceedings in the District Court of this County for the purchase of said above tracts, parcels and pieces of land in Tulsa County for the construction, operation and maintenance of the levee on the North bank of the Arkansas River and for the benefit of Tulsa County as a whole.

The application of the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company for the use of certain highways of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, was presented and after hearing and discussion of said application, the following resolution, upon motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, the resolution was carried and adopted.

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, under date of August 1st, 1938, has made application for the use of certain highways of Tulsa County for the purpose of transmitting and selling electricity for light, heat and power purposes, and

WHEREAS, IT APPEARS THAT SAID Company is entitled under the laws to use the said highways for such purposes, and Whereas, it appears that the use of such highways will not interfere with, or impede traffic and that such service is at this time demanded by customers to be served by said line.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that we, the Board of County Commissioners, in regular meeting, do hereby give our consent to the use of the following highways in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, by the Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, its successors and assigns, for the purpose of transmitting and selling electric current, said highway being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the Northwest corner of Section 24, T17N, R13E, which is the Northwestern city limits of the City of Bixby, Oklahoma, and running North along the West side of Section 13-T17N - R14E, a distance of approximately 1,320 feet.

Said line to be constructed on whichever side of said highway as may be necessary to avoid conflict with present telephone lines. This consent includes the right to ~~xxx~~ cross all intersecting roads or highways and is conditioned that said line shall be built in accordance with the standards prescribed by the State of Oklahoma through the Corporation Commission under its Order Number 1936. Said line shall be constructed as near to the side of the road as is practicable and not more than four (4) feet from the outside boundary of highway right of way. A map showing the route of said line is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

The Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company will at any and all times remove any poles or lines that might be necessary to be moved on account of construction or maintenance of highways without any cost to Tulsa County, and that the same shall be so removed or constructed upon written notice signed by the County Engineer of Tulsa County within a period of ten days.

The Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company will place all poles along the highway and particularly at intersections of the highway in such manner that there will be no hazard to traffic and to save Tulsa County from any damage of whatsoever nature or kind that might occur to either public or private property at such time as said work is performed.
