Motion was made and seconded that Petition as presented relative to sanitary conditions at the Tulsa County Farm be and the same is hereby referred to J P McLane, Supt.

Motion was made by Mr. North, seconded by Mr. Hedgecock, that the Petition filed by Citizens, asking for paved road from the Western terminus of the paved road west of West Tulsa along the south side of the Arkansas River be referred to the County Engineer with instructions to make preliminary investigation and report back to the Board of County Commissioners as soon as possible. Carried.

WHEREAS, The Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to A M ENGEL of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Eighty and 02/100 (\$80.02) Dollars the following described land:

AND, WHEREAS, the sale of said land by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 9745 of the Compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1921, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax re-sale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Skiatook News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treasurer would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of Deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners and no other persons having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said land, and the County of Tulsa has no need for said land for any purpose required and provided by law whatsoever.
