Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that the Sand Springs Railway Company be granted permission to occupy a portion of the County Highway, beginning at a point on the East line of the County road and 20' East and 215.5' North of the quarter corner between Section 7-Township 19 N-Range 12 E, and Section 12-Township 19 N-Range 11 E, Tulsa County; thence in a southwesterly direction on a curve to the left, radius 819.02! a distance of 267.5!; thence southerly on a tangent to the last described curve a distance of 804.91; thence Southwesterly on a curve to the right, radius of which is 764.49' a distance of 47.1'. Also beginning at a point on the West line of the 'County road 25' West 341.1' North of the meander corner of the left bank of the Arkansas River between Section 7, Township 19 N, Range 12 E, and Section 12, Township 19 N, Range 11 E, Tulsa County; thence extending Southeasterly on a curve to the left, the radius of which is 560.46' a distance of 146.9' to a point on the South line of River Street in Lake Station, a subdivision to Tulsa County. This property is adjacent to the highway, what is commonly called Lake Station road and is now occupied by the Sand Springs Railway Company and used for right of way purposes. Upon roll call, all members voting in the 'affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the following order be approved. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Gray, Yes; Hopkins, Yes. Motion carried.

ORDER

WHEREAS, the Treasurer of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, has filed and presented to the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, an application for the issuance to LIZZIE WHITE of a deed conveying to him for a consideration of Two Hundred and No/100 dollars (\$200.00) the following described lot:

Lot 7, Blk. 5, Booker-Washington Add. to Tulsa, Oklahoma.

AND WHEREAS, the sale of said lot by the County Treasurer was made pursuant to Section 12755 of the compiled Statutes of Oklahoma of 1931, and amendments thereto, whereby the County Treasurer is authorized to sell lands and lots purchased for the County by him at tax resale, and

WHEREAS, due notice has been given and published by the County Treasurer in the Tulsa Daily Legal News, the official paper of the County of Tulsa, that said County Treasurer would on this date apply to the Board of County Commissioners for an order approving said sale, and directing the issuance of deed therefor, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such notice, hearing on such sale has been had by the Board of County Commissioners, and no other person having appeared to bid a higher price for the purchase of said lot and the County of Tulsa has no need for said lot for any purpose required and provided whatsoever.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in regular session assembled and pursuant to the aforesaid statutes of the State of Oklahoma, hereby approve the sale of said property so made by the County Treasurer to LIZZIE WHITE for a consideration of \$200.00, and it is hereby ordered that the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners execute to LIZZIE WHITE a deed conveying to him all the right, title and interest of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, in and to said property, and the County Clerk of Tulsa County is hereby directed to attest with his signature and attach the seal of his office.
