The Board of County Commissioners met in their rooms in the County Court House, at 1:30 P.M. present Cyrus S. Avery, A. W. Lucas, and Lewis Cline, County Clerk, absent Ed. Baker.

The petition of Arleye F. Gibbs of Wekiwa Twp, for the appointment of Justice of the Peace was presented, with his bond, to the board, after considering, a motion was made that he be appointed as such Justice of Wekiwa Twp, and his bond was approved.

The next order of business was appointing jurors to appraise a roadway in Section 33, Twp 19, Range 11, W. C. Best, H. E. Bridges, and F. O. Brown, were appointed viewers to assess the damages, and the County Clerk was ordered to so notify them.

An order was made that the Tulsa Democrat be designated to print the Commissioners Proceedings until January 1st 1917, at Twenty-five cents an inch.

There being no further business, they adjourned to meet Monday, June 5th, 1916.
