

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 22nd, 1922.

Pursuant to adjournment the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, met in the office of the Commissioners' in the Tulsa County Court House, with all members present, the following proceedings were had.

A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by George E. Gilmore that the following order be and is hereby made in the matter of the application of the Sand Springs Home, a corporation, for the right and authority to construct a 36 inch metal pipe line under, across and through the public highways of the County of Tulsa, Oklahoma, for the purpose of transmitting and selling water to oil refineries, industries, manufacturing enterprises and inhabitants of said Tulsa County.

O R D E R.

NOW on this 22nd day of March, 1922, the application of the Sand Springs Home a corporation, for the construction of a 36 inch metal pipe line across the following public highways located in Tulsa County at the following places and points, to wit:

(1) Across, under and through the north and south concrete road (Sand Springs Keystone) beginning at a point just south of the intersection of the above road, and the east and west concrete road on the south boundry of Sand Springs.

(2) Across, under and through the public highway of Tulsa County, beginning at a point in the road and 30 feet south of the East and West center line from a point 400 feet west of the 1.4 corner sections 11 and 14, T. 19 N., R. 11 E., to a point 900 feet east of the 1.4 corner sections 11 and 14, Township 19 North, Range 11 East. Thence on a 13 degree curve to left across the road for 153.8' thence on a ten degree curve 50 feet to the north side of road.

(3) Across the north and south road 37 feet north of Southeast corner Section 11, Township 19 north, Range 11 East.

(4) Across the north and south road 105 feet north of Meander corner left bank Arkansas River Section 12, Township 19 north Range 11 East, and section 7, Township 19 north range 12 East.

coming on to be heard, the board finds that the Sand Springs Home is a corporation duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oklahoma, and that it is authorized by its charter to furnish water to various factories, industries, refineries and other manufacturing enterprises within the count of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and that the said Sand Springs Home has made various contracts with factories, oil refineries, and manufacturing enterprises and inhabitants living and residing within the said County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma to furnish said water to them.

The Board further finds that it is necessary for the Sand Springs Home in order to furnish the said water to the said refineries, factories and inhabitants of said Tulsa County to lay, build, construct, maintain and operate a thirty-six inch metal water pipe line across the following public highways situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and at the following places and points to wit:

(1) Across, under and through the north and south concrete road (Sand Springs Keystone) beginning at a point just south of the intersection of the above road, and the east and west concrete road on the south boundry of Sand Springs.

(2) Across, under and through the public highway of Tulsa County, beginning at a point in the road and 30 feet south of the East and West center line from a point 400 feet west of the 1.4 corner sections 11 and 14 T. 19 N., R 11 E., to a point 900 feet east of the 1.4 corner sections 11 and 14, Township 19 north, Range 11 east. Thence on a 13 degree curve to left across the road for 153.8', thence on a 10 degree curve 50 feet to the
