#### R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 861.10, Title 19 O. S. Suppl. 1949, the Tulsa County Planning Commission has adopted Regulations governing the subdivision of land within the unincorporated areas of Tulsa County; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said statutory provisions, it is deemed necessary in order to protect and carry out such Regulations and make them effective, for this Board to adopt minimum standards and specifications for the surfacing, paving and construction of streets and roadways and appurtenances thereto, within such subdivisions and provide for the examination and inspection thereof as constructed, and to authorize the issuance of certificates of approval thereof, and to charge and collect fees to cover the cost of such examination, inspection and certification, all of same being deemed necessary and incidental to the full exercise of the authority so given and the responsibility so placed on this Board.
