(3) Across the north and south road 37 feet north of south East corner Section 11, Township 19 north, Range 11 East.

(4) Across the north and south road 105 feet north of meander corner left bank Arkansas River Sections 12, Township 19 North, Range 11 East, and Section 7, Township 19 north, Range 12 East.

It is therefore ordered that the Sand Springs Home be and is hereby authorized to and is granted the right to construct, lay, build maintain and operate <sup>and repair</sup> a 36 inch pipe line across the following public high ways located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, at the following places and points, to wit:

(1) Across ~~it~~ under and through the north and south concrete road (Sand Springs- Keystone) beginning at a point just south of the intersection of the above road, and the east and west concrete road on the south boundary of sand Springs.

(2) Across, under and through the public highway of Tulsa County, beginning at a point in the road 30 feet south of the east and west center line from a point 400 feet west of the 1/4 corner sections 11 and 14, Township 19 north, Range 11 East to a point 900 feet east of the 1/4 corner sections 11 and 14, township 19 north, Range 11 East, thence on a 13 degree curve to left across the road for 153.8', thence on a 10 degree curve 50 feet to the north side of the road.

(3) Across the north and south road 37 feet north of southwest corner of section 11, Township 19 north, Range 11 East.

(4) Across the north and south road 105 feet north of meander corner left bank Arkansas River Section 12, Township 19 north, Range 11 East and Section 7, Township 19 north, Range 12 East.

And do all things necessary to the successful construction of said pipe line across the said highways at the said points, said metal pipe line to be constructed in a workmanlike manner.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the construction of said 36 inch metal water pipe line across the said highways at the above described points and places shall be made under the supervision and direction of the County Engineer, and in such places and manner consistent with necessity to least interfere with other public uses of said highway, and said highway shall not be unnecessarily obstructed and shall within a reasonable time be placed as near as practicable in as good condition and repair as before such construction, at the expense of the Sand Springs Home, and that the Sand Springs Home will hold the county harmless from any liability arising from any negligence, acts, or omissions on the part of the said Sand Springs Home in the construction of said 36 inch metal pipe line across said public highways.
