The matter of vacating the road running South from South End of Main Street in Bixby, Oklahoma. H. Taylor appeared before the Board with two petitions one requesting that the above road be abandoned and the other requesting that the road be left where it now is.

Motion made by Cleveland that the petition be granted and one road abandoned, the other established as new petition, seconded by McKahan. Motion carried Yeas 3 Nays none. Notice of discontinuance of road was issued to be served on Ada Fox & Luke Fox, her Guardian. Motion by Cleveland seconded by McKahan that \$150.00 out of the appropriation to Tulsa Fair Association be used by The Tulsa Fair Association for Poultry Show. Yeas 3 Nays none. Petition presented requesting that John Schellenberger be appointed Drainage Commissioner in City Drainage Dist. No. 1. Petition canvassed found to comply with the law and a motion by Cleveland seconded by McKahan was allowed. Yeas 3 Nays none.
