Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the Welfare Department be granted \$2,500 for groceries for the month of August, 1938. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that \$3,000 be allocated for hospitalization for the month of August, 1938, same to be divided as follows: Morningside Hospital \$1,700; Sisler Hospital \$900.00; St. Johns Hospital \$100.00; Tulsa General Hospital \$100.00; Poole Hospital \$100.00; and Flower Hospital \$100.00. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the following amounts be allocated to the following for drugs and supplies for the month of August, 1938. Red Fork \$30.00; Sperry \$25.00; Skiatook \$10.00; Dr. Smith \$50.00; Sand Springs \$25.00; Collinsville \$80.00; Bixby \$80.00; Broken Arrow 60.00; Jenks \$35.00; Dr. Motley \$75.00; Dr. Barham \$150.00; Dr. Roberts \$50.00; Dr. McGuire \$5.00; Dr. Roberts for the jail \$100.00; for the clinic \$100.00; to the various drug stores for prescriptions, to be divided as follows: Dr. Roberts \$100.00; Dr. McGuire \$25.00; Dr. Motley \$50.00; Dr. Barham \$225.00. To Dr. Childs is allocated \$60.00 and to Dr. Hairston \$40.00 for services and supplies. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that \$200.00 be set in the budget for the fiscal year 1938-39 for the purchase of jars for canning purposes at the Broken Arrow canning factory and the various schools. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the Tulsa Daily Legal News be appointed the official County publication and that the County Commissioners' proceedings and all County legal notices be published in said publication. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Hopkins, Yes; Gray, Yes. Motion carried.
