Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Couch, and unanimously carried, that, upon the recommendation of Garrett Newman, County Assessor, and Hugh Webster, Assistant County Attorney, the Application of Erroneous Assessment of Guy Brewer on Real Estate for the years 1945 and 1946 be, and the same is hereby approved, and the County Clerk is hereby ordered to issue Certificate of Error covering same.

Upon the instruction of the Chairman of the Board of County Commissioners, the following sealed Bid for the furnishing of two 152 foot steel truss spans, 16 Ft. wide or better, was opened: T. J. Anderson's bid, in the amount of \$24,000.00, together with his bid check for \$2,400.00. Anderson.
