AND, it further appearing to this Board that an appeal having been lodged with said County Superintendent, claiming to have been signed by at least one quarter of the qualified voters of said Common School District No 12, wherein an appeal from the action of the County Superintendent is sought, and said appeal having been heretofore assigned to be heard by the Board of County Commissioners on this day and hour, and the parties interested having been so informed and apprised that said appeal would come on for hearing on this day and hour, and none of the interested parties taking said appeal, have appeared to prosecute the same, it was moved by Member North and seconded by Member Hedgecock that the appeal from the action and order of the County Superintendent of Public Instruction in annexing Common School District No 12, to Independent District No. 22 City of Tulsa, be and the same is hereby dismissed for failure to prosecute the same.
