

shall be considered as rental, and all of the said teams and equipment shall be returned in good condition to the party of the first part.

IT IS ALSO AGREED THAT THE second party shall carry reasonable insurance on the said property as a protection to the first party until the full purchase price has been paid, in an amount satisfactory to the first party.

THE Second party agrees to protect the said teams and equipment by proper maintenance, treatment, etc., and failure to so do, or for other default in the conditions of this contract, first party shall have the right to demand the return of said property, and cause cancellation of this agreement.

PARTY OF THE SECOND PART, shall not remove the said teams and equipment from out the confines of Tulsa County at any time before the final payment therefor, unless permission is obtained from the first party and under such conditions of security as said first party may prescribe.

All of which the parties hereunto have this the 28th day of March, 1922, agreed to, and that same shall be in effect as of said date.
