Dear Mr. Miller:

As you know, two charges were filed against me yesterday in connection with my management of the County Farm.

In view of the fact that I am an employee of Tulsa County, it might be advisable for me during the pendency of these actions to ask that a leave of absence without pay pending the trial of the above cases.

I do not wish to embarrass the Board of County Commissioners, and I know that when these cases are tried that I will be absolutely exonerated. However, I do request that until such time as these cases are tried that I be granted a leave of absence from my job without pay, but request that I be allowed to live in the house, as it will be but a very short time until my cases are tried and a final determination had therein.

Of course, I will pay for my own keep during the time that I have this leave of absence, and such groceries and supplies as I have on hand that belong to the County I am ready and willing to turn over to any person that you might name to look after the County Farm during this ~~leave~~ leave of absence. And I wish that you would as soon as possible select someone to take over my duties until such time as my leave of absence expires.
