Norvell, Judge of the Juvenile Court of Tulsa County, accruing on and after July 1, 1949, and that said Judge of said Juvenile Court is hereby authorized and directed to pay the same, pursuant to proper claims, out of the budget of the Juvenile Court of Tulsa County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVES that the Honorable Walter Marks, Judge of the County Court of Tulsa County, be and he is hereby instructed, directed and requested to refrain from taking, receiving or filing any juvenile case or matter after the close of business July 15, 1949, and to transfer all transferrable matters to the Juvenile Court of Tulsa County after July 15, 1949.
