## MONDAY.JANUARY 10th.1927

Pursuant to adjournment, the Board of County Commissioners met in their office in regularly adjourned session, with all members present: W W Stuckey, Chairman, W L North and Ed W Hedgecock, Members. Meeting called to order by Chairman Stuckey. Reading of the minutes of previous meeting dispensed with and it is ordered that they stand approved.

In the matter of the petition of the Oklahoma Natural Gas Company, the following order was made:

ORDER

NOW, On this the 10th. day of Jamuary, 1927, the metter of the Petition of Oklahoma Natural Gas Corporation for permission to lay a pipe line along, under and across certain highways in said County and State came up before the Board of County Commissioners of said County for hearing, and it appearing to the Board and each of the Commissioners thereof, that it was just that the said Oklahoma Natural Gas cCorporation be permitted to use as much of the highways as designated by plat filed by said Corporation, and according to said description, which is a s follows:, to-wit:

Beginning at a point near the Northwest Corner of the intersection of South Lewis Avenue and 31st. Street and running thence West along the North side of 31st. Street a distance of 854 feet, thence in a Southerly direction along the West Side of Ridgeway Avenue approximately 700 feet, thence in a Westerly and Northwesterly direction following the North and East Side of Bren Rose Boulevard approximately 2100 feet, thence West a distance of 338 feet to a connection with pipe line now in place. This line known as "Service Lines - City of Tulsa" in Bren-Rose Addition, a sub-division of a part of the North Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 19 North, Range 13, East, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

AND, it further appearing from the Petition herein that said pipe line will be so constructed as not to interfere with any of the rights of the general public in the use of said highways; and will be constructed in accordance with all rules of the County Commissioners and the laws of the State of Oklahoma governing same.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED by the Board of County Commissioners of said County that permission be granted, and the same is hereby granted to Oklahoma Natural Cas Corporation, its successors and assigns, to use as much of the highways as above designated.
