Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 4:00 o'clock P.M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that Cobb Markham be appointed Superintendent of the County Farm & Home during the leave of absence given S. W. Campbell; salary of Mr. Markham to be \$150.00 per month. Upon roll call, the following vote was taken: Miller, Yes; Hopkins, Yes; Gray, Yes. Motion carried.
