RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY CLERK TO GIVE  
NOTICE OF LETTING CONTRACT FOR SEWER LINE  
IN DRAINAGE DISTRICT NUMBER 12.

WHEREAS, the plans for the construction of the Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12 Legee, as prepared by the U.S. Engineers, require the elimination of the existing 24" Sanitary Sewer which now runs from the Southwest Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section 12, Twp. 19N, Range 11E, southerly through the property of the Sinclair Refining Company in Section 13, Twp. 19N, Range 11E, to the Arkansas River, and

WHEREAS, it becomes necessary to conduct the sanitary sewage now handled by the said 24" Sewer, easterly for a distance of 2380 feet, more or less, to an existing 24" combined sewer which latter sewer will be equipped with a pump station which will pump the flow therefrom over the levee when the river is higher than the sewer outfall, and

WHEREAS, the cost of doing this work has been estimated and included in Viewer's report and is part of the necessary expense of cleaning the right of way of the levee and is, therefore, a just cost to be borne by Drainage District Number 12, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, acting in behalf of said Drainage District No. 12, as provided by law, does hereby direct the Consulting Engineers for said Drainage District to prepare plans, specifications and contract documents necessary for procuring sealed bids for the construction of said Sewer, and hereby direct the County Clerk to give ten days publication notice, as required by law, in the Tulsa Daily World, that said plans and specifications for such sewer line may be obtained from the Consulting Engineers, Wood & Craig, Room 317 Philtower Building, Tulsa, Oklahoma, or the County Engineer at the County Court House, and that bids will be received for the construction of the said sewer in the office of the County Commissioners up to ten o'clock A.M., October 25th, 1943, and will be opened by eleven o'clock A.M., on said day, reserving the right to reject any and all bids - requiring the successful bidder to give a valid bond of not less than \$7,500.00 with Cashier's Check attached to his bid of five per cent of such bid.

Said Resolution was thereupon read, and on motion of Commissioner Greer, and seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, and a roll call and vote being had thereon, the Chairman declared same unanimously adopted.
