RESOLUTION DESIGNATING COUNTY HIGHWAY.

WHEREAS, SENATE BILL NO. 44 of the Extraordinary Session of the 9th. Oklahoma Legislature, 1924, provides among other things for the designation of the County Highways,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Board of County Commissioners of Tulsa County, that a County Highway be declared along the following lines:

"Beginning at the corners of Sections 7-8, 17 and 18, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, and extending Three (3) Miles East to the corners of Section 10-11, 14 and 15, same Township and Range.

Also, beginning at the entrance to the County Fair Grounds on the South line of Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, and following north along the most advantageous line to 15th. Street; thence West along 15th. Street to Harvard Avenue.

And, Be It Further Resolved, That the County Engineer be instructed to immediately prepare plans and specifications and to advertise for bids for the paving from Harvard Avenue, East to entrance to Fair Grounds, and to take appropriate action to grade and oil, or otherwise improve the last above designation.

The above Resolution was introduced by J.S.Shaver, member of the Board who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by W.L.North, and upon roll call the vote to adopt was as follows:
