

Friday-- August 15th, 1938.

Pursuant to recess heretofore taken, the Board of County Commissioners re-convened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present: John H. Miller, Chairman; J. B. Gray and Harry L. Hopkins members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk

John H. Miller, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

Reading of the minutes of the previous meeting was dispensed with and there being no objection to the same they were ordered to stand approved.

Motion by Commissioner Hopkins, seconded by Commissioner Miller, that the Bond filed by J. Lacy Ballenger Abstract Company in the amount of \$ 5,000 written by the Continental Casualty Company, be and the same is hereby approved and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that R. L. Jones, be and he is hereby appointed Constable in and for District No. 7, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, subject to the approval of his bond. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the \$1,000 personal bond filed by R. L. Jones, Constable in and for District No. 7, Tulsa County, Oklahoma, be and the same is hereby approved. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the report filed by Water Improvement District No. 5, covering a period from January 1st, 1938 to June 30th, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Gray, seconded by Commissioner Hopkins, that the monthly report filed by the Clerk of the Court of Common Pleas for the month of July, 1938, be and the same is hereby accepted and filed. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
