RESOLUTION OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS PRIMARY TO LETTING BRIDGE AND CULVERT CONTRACTS.

The following resolution was thereupon proposed by Cyrus S.Avery, Chairman, and its adoption moved by him. The same was seconded by A.W.Lucas, Commissioner, and upon the vote being taken, the same was adopted with the following vote::

Said resolution was as follows, to-wit:

Whereas it is the opinion of the County Commissioners of Tulsa County, Oklahoma in meeting assemble, this 5th day of June 1916, that it is for the best interest of the County of Tulsa, and for the comfort and covenience of the citizens thereof, that permanent bridges and (or) culverts should be built and constructed in Tulsa County, and WHEREAS, Plans and specifications for said bridges have been prepared and filed with the County Clerk of Tulsa County, for the bridges and (ar) culverts hereinafter named and described.
