Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that E. T. Neibling's salary be paid up to and including the 15th of October, 1943, at the rate of \$170.00 per month. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Kinkaid, seconded by Commissioner Gray, that Mrs. Pearl Haugh be appointed as Bookkeeper in the County Highway Department in District #3, at the salary of \$160.00 per month effective October 25th, 1943.
