Motion made by Commissioner Bailey, seconded by Commissioner Evans, and unanimously carried, that the County Attorney be and he is hereby authorized to take appropriate action for the recovery of the $\mathbb{W}^1_{\mathbb{Z}}$ of the \mathbb{SE}^1_{4} of the $\mathbb{SW}^1_{\mathbb{Z}}$, Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 13 East, to which the City of Tulsa asserts claim under a Lease Contract of February 19, 1946.

Motion made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Bailey, and unanimously carried that the Bond of Alton McKnight, Constable, Division 1, District 4, in the amount of \$1,000.00, made by the Western Surety Company, be and the same is hereby approved.
