

MINUTES

THURSDAY, OCTOBER 24, 1985

The Board of County Commissioners for Tulsa County, Oklahoma met at the hour of 9:00 a.m., with the following members present: Lewis Harris, Chairman; John Selph, Member. Members absent: Melvin C. Rice. Others present: Clayton Edwards, Susan Morgan, Mike Kimbrell, Keith Hamilton, George Phillips, Richard Bales.

Lewis Harris, Chairman, presiding, called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m., and the following business was transacted:

County Treasurer John Cantrell appeared to explain his desire to get rid of 33 tax resale properties because of maintenance costs and potential liabilities. Chairman directed Edwards to draft letter from BOCC to County Assessor requesting the properties be re-appraised toward final re-sale. Subject will be discussed further later.

Cantrell and Phillips explained a request for procedural change in a park depository fund. No action taken; Chairman directed Edwards to place subject on November 14, 1985 Management Conference agenda.

Phillips explained his October 2, 1985 request to close O'Brien and Bixby Recreation Centers for 2½ days November 18, 19, and 20; Phillips wants several Park Department employees to attend Oklahoma Recreation and Park Society conference during that time. Motion by Harris, seconded by Selph, to close as requested. Motion carried.
