MONDAY, October 25th, 1943

Pursuant to notice heretofore given, the Board of County Commissioners reconvened at the hour of 10:00 o'clock A. M., with all members present: J. B. Gray, Chairman; Curtis Greer and Robt. L. Kinkaid, members. Andy Stokes, County Clerk.

J. B. Gray, Chairman presiding, the following business was transacted.

This being the day set for the opening of the bids on the Contract for a Sanitary Sewer to be constructed in connection with Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12. The following bids were received, to-wit:

Ottinger Brothers	13,500.00

The above bids were referred to the County Engineer and Wood & Craig, Consulting Engineers, for compilation upon motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that a recess be taken until 2:00 o'clock P. M. Motion carried.

Motion by Commissioner Greer, seconded by Commissioner Kinkaid, that the contract on the Sanitary Sewer to be constructed in connection with Tulsa County Drainage District No. 12, be awarded F. M. Stowell, F. M. Stowell being the lowest bidder in the amount of \$6,644.00. Upon roll call, all members voting in the affirmative, motion was by the Chairman declared carried.
