40- EARTH EXCAVATION. ITEM 1.

Shall include excavation of all materials specified above, including borrow except as provided below for loose and solid rock excavation, and shall include ald macadam and sod to a depth of three (3") inches, when the same may be ordered by the Engineer.

41.- LOOSE ROCK. ITEM NO. 2.

Shall include all stone, boulders and detached rock laying in its original position in separate masses of more then three (3') cubic feet and less than one half (1/2) cubic yard in size, and all slate, soap stone, cement gravel, course grable in boulders and hard pan.

42.- ROCK EXCAVATION. ITEM NO. 2 A

Shall include excavation of all boulders more than one half (1/2) cubic yard in volume and all large rocks and other material which is so hard that it is not practicable to loosen with pick and shovle. The prices bid for earth excavation and borrow, loose and solid rock excavations shall cover all labor, materials, supplies, plant, tools and incidentals for the removal, delivery and etc., of excavated materials in embankments or spoilxx banks, and for hauling, compacting, rolling and grading the same, and all other work incidental thereto.

43. OVERHAUL. ITEM NO. 3.

If the haul on the excavated material, either from cuts, of borrow pits, made in accordance with directions form the engineer exceeds five hundred (500') feet, measured along the shortest practicable line of haul, from the sourse of supply to the place of depositation, it shall be classified as OVERHAUL. For each One Hundred (100') feet of haul greater the Five Hundred (500') feet, the contractor shall receive the price bid for overhaul per cubic yard of all materials so removed, measured in its original position. The price bid shall cover all labor, appliances and incidentals necessary to complete the work.

44,-EXTRA, OR FORCE ACCOUNT WORK.
On all work not specifically and herein provided for and for which no provision has been made as to payment, which may be ordered in writing by the engineer, shall be known as extra or force account work, and shall be paid for at cost, plus the per centage shawn in the contracotrs proposal. which provision is herein made for that work.
