A motion was made by F. M. Wooden and sconded by Ira Short that the bids received for the construction of Park View Drainage District No. 2, be referred to T. C. Hughes, Engineer, for compilation. Motion carried.

## Adjourned to three o'clock.

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahome met pursuant to adjournement, with all members present, and the above compilation of bids was submitted for consideration, whereupon a motion was made by F. M. Wooden and seconded by Ira Short that the bids of theDahlstrom Improvement Company and Craig and Shaw, both of Tulsa, Oklahoma, the two lowest bidders, be retained, and that the letting of the contract be deferred until Monday April 17th, 1922. All members voting in the affirmative, the motion was by the chairman declared carried.

A motion was made by Ira Short and seconded by F. M. Wooden that the checks of the unsuccessful bidders on the Park View Drainage District No. 2, or the bonds given in lies of the certified checks be returned. Motion carried.

In regard to the application of the Board of County Commissioners for additional and supplemental appropriation for the current fiscal year, to be made by the Deputy State Examiner and Inspector, the following letter was submitted and approved.

"HON. Geo. E. Gilmore, Chairman Hon. Ira Short, Hon. F. M. Wooden, Board of County Commissioners, Tulsa County.

Gentlemen: -

I find, to-day that it is practically impossible for me to prepare a Financial statement for supplemental appropriation, General Fund, as of March 31st,. To do this work will consume all of ten days, and our force is now overburdened with other work which must be gotten out of the way, so that we could not begin on the Financial Statement until so late in this month that the application for supplemental appropriation could not be filed within this month.

It is our intention, in making this application, to go through all of the claims of this fiscal year and classify same properly, in order to precisely determine the department and account needing additional appropriation. This feature of the application will consume six days, and hence, I have concluded to prepare the application as at the close of business April 30th, 1922, in order that we will not require further additional appropriations.

Now, in regard to your purchasing the additional land for the Poor Farm. It will not be necessary to delay this purchase, and as soon as you are ready to complete the same a claim can be honored and a warrant drawn in payment thereof, and the same can be charged to the Poor and Insane Account until April 30th, at which time we will charge it out of that account and have an appropriation made to cover. We will have ample surplus to take care of this citem.
